Sullivan's March (also called Sullivan's Expedition) in August and September 1779 brought a 3,500-man army up the Susquehanna River valley from Wilkes-Barre to eradicate the frontier settlements of the Native Americans who were the allies of the British during the American Revolution. Encampments were located every 8 to 10 miles along the river in what later became Wyoming and Bradford counties.



Historical markers for several encampments can be found along Pa. Rt. 92 and U.S. Rts. 6 and 220 in both counties. An additional 1,500 troops under General Clinton came downriver from Lake Otsego and joined Sullivan's forces at Tioga Point (present day Athens).
